



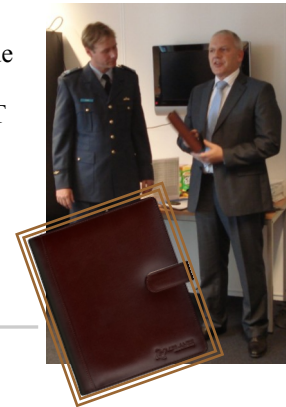
Vigilance ISR Academy Imagery Analyst Guide

Introduction to ISR for Managers Course (IISRC-4 days)

ISR = An activity that synchronizes and integrates the planning and operation of sensors, assets, and processing, exploitation, and dissemination systems in direct support of current and future operations. This is an integrated intelligence and operations function.

ISR (intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance) assets are integrated capabilities designed to collect, process, and disseminate information necessary to plan and conduct operations. ISR assets cover a wide range of ground and airborne platforms, most of which are considered "low density – high demand," highlighting their small numbers and frequent need.

Course Description

Vigilance ISR Academy has developed a 4 days introduction course where ISR Fundamentals will be explained. Attendees gain an overview of ISR technologies, sensors and both manned- and unmanned platforms and their capacities will be discussed. During this course, the focus will be at the ISR Cycle, the *man-in-the-loop* and the need for standardization.

This course has been developed for Engineers, Technicians and Managers with (future) ISR related jobs.

Course Description

- Advanced IA Techniques (Incl. Camouflage, Concealment & Detection, BDA studies,)
- Advanced Strategic weapons and Industries studies
- Terrain studies
- Multi-Source Imagery, including EO, SAR, IR, Hyper Spectral and FMV.

The three week course may be extended with one practical week
